





Feedback on Curriculum

Objective:-

MNR Dental College aims to offer the best possible learning experience to encourage students to perform to their full potential. The feedback committee of the college thus, designed feedback forms framed with structured questions, which were relevant and related to various aspects of the present curriculum. An additional suggestions section was added to the questionnaire. This plays a key role in assessing the success of academic provision in relation to the expectations of various stakeholders.

Methodology:-

The questionnaires were circulated among the stakeholders like students, teachers, employers, alumni and professionals. Duly filled forms were collected from them. The whole process was done in an entirely anonymous and confidential manner. Their responses regarding the curriculum were assessed on several parameters using the Likert type four point scale ranging from Very Good to Unsatisfactory. The parameters that were included are learning value in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, applicability/ relevance to real life situations, depth of course content, extent of coverage of course, clarity and relevance of reading material etc.

Analysis & Results:-

Responses given by the stakeholders were analysed by the chairperson of the committee. Results have been produced in the form of bar diagrams showing the percentage of different types of responses obtained.

Suggestions have been made by the feedback committee to addrocc all the grievances related to curricular aspects. Accordingly, a relevant plan of action would be designed and carried out after the approval from higher authorities.









NUMBER OF RESPONSES OBTAINED = 01







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
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ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-2019



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Action Taken Report regarding Feedback on Curriculum 2018-2019

The feedback committee of MNR Dental College had conducted a survey for obtaining the annual feedback on curriculum. It is collected from various stakeholders of the college like students, teachers, employers, alumni, and professionals. The obtained feedback was summarised and analysed to draw up the results in the form of bar diagrams. An additional suggestions section was also added to the questionnaire.

The following are the observations from the feedback obtained:

- The students have requested to increase the field visits which would help them to gain more clinical knowledge.
- The staff have requested to start conducting faculty development programs.

Action Taken:

Regarding the above suggestions drawn from the feedback, a meeting was organised by the feedback committee of the institution. All the points were taken to the notice of the IQAC, the Principal and the Management. The following actions were taken.

- A circular was made instructing to organise more number of field visits/ camps which
 could be attended by the students during their internship to develop more clinical
 knowledge. This would also be helpful in their personality development by instilling a
 service oriented mindset.
- IQAC had taken initiation to conduct faculty development programs regarding resource planning, clinical trials, biomedical & health research which would help staff gain a research attitude.
