Validity of Agreement:

This agreement is valid for Two years from the date of agreement i.e. from 1st December 2021 to 30th November 2023 for 680 beds only.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

I. Responsibility of the Second Party

- The second party shall take necessary steps to ensure that the waste is handled without adverse effects to human health and environment.
- The second party shall segregate the waste at the point of generation in accordance with Schedule I of Bio-medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2016 and in compliance with standards prescribed.
- The second party shall establish common secured waste collection point within the premises for collection and lifting of Bio- Medical Waste by the first party.
- 4. The second party shall designate Nodal Officer at Unit listed above to interact with the First party.
- 5. As per the agreement that the Second Party is liable to pay the agreed charges.
- The second party shall obtain authorization from the Telangana State Pollution Control Board.
- The second party shall furnish annual report regarding generation, collection, storage, transportation and disposal of Bio medical wastes in the prescribed format to the prescribed authority.
- 8. The second party shall maintain all the relevant documents or records and make the reports of the Accidents if any.
- The second party shall disinfect the sharps and mutilate them and have them over in Puncture Proof Container to the first party.
- Microbiological waste should be given to M/s Dharma & Co after auto calving.

II. Services to be provided by the First Party

- The first party shall collect the segregated Bio-Medical Waste from the identified common waste collection point at hospital.
- 2. The first party shall transport the segregated Bio-Medical Waste in a closed container vehicle to the treatment facility.

3. The first party shall be responsible for collection, transport, appropriate a streatment and disposal of wastes at the treatment facility as per the

provisions of Bio-medical Waste (Management & Handling), 2016.

- 4. The first party shall also undertake testing of treated waste to ensure safety to the environment.
- 5. The liquid waste and effluent generated during the course of treatment shall be treated in an effluent treatment plant by the first party.
- 6. The first party shall be responsible for the disposal of treated waste in the secure landfill or any recycling plant or incineration.
- The first party shall give appropriate training to the personnel handling the waste of second party on bio medical waste management and handling.
- The first party shall issue the service certificate of registration and the same should be displayed in the second party's office premises for identification.
- The first party will obtain all the valid approvals/documents from Telangana Pollution Control Board, Telangana for collection, transport, treatment and safe disposal of biomedical waste and give the copies of such documents to the second party for its record.
- 10. First party will provide necessary Non Chlorinated bags in the name of M/s Ram shiva plasto needs if desired by M/S MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, on nominal prices. We are supplying bill to bill only. Each and every Non Chlorinated bags should have unique QR code. Without QR code label M/S Dharma & Co will not collect the bio medical waste and same will informed to TSPCB. We will not collect the Improper Bio medical waste segregation and same will informed to TSPCB.
- 11. The first party shall collect the biomedical waste from second party premises at such times and for such frequency as mutually agreed by both the parties.
 - 12. The collected waste material sent by the hospital may be checked and suggestions may be given for improvement in the segregation of the waste by the first party.

MODE OF PAYMENT

A payment of Rs.5.835/- for per bed per day (Five rupees Eight Thirty Five Paisa only ie: Rupees 1,19,000/-) for 680 Beds irrespective of occupancy shall be paid towards service charges on monthly basis in the first week of the following month and from 1st December 2021 to 30th November 2022.

A payment of Rs.6.13/- for per bed per day (Six rupees Thirteen paisa only le: Rupees 1,25,000/-) for 680 Beds irrespective of occupancy shall be paid towards service charges on monthly basis in the first week of the following month and from 1st December 2022 to 30th November 2023.

If the bed strength increased during the term of agreement charges will be levied to the increased bed strength.

The first party shall submit a bill on the 1st week of every month indicating complete details of service provided to Unit for the last month. The payment of the bill should be made before 15th of the every month. Second party will provide the payment details by e-mail with complete details like invoice number, for the month details, payment amount and payment details. Second party should provide the payment statement every six months.

Terms of pricing and payment will be reviewed after Nov 2023, if necessary depending upon the price index, inflation of the rates, whatever it may be and will be revised as per mutually agreed terms, if necessary.

PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

The first party shall comply with the provisions of Bio-medical Waste (Management & Handling) 2016 and Rules and Regulations stipulated by the Telangana Pollution Control Board.

The first party is not liable for improper waste Segregation by the Second party at the common secured waste collection point within the premises of the Unit, First party will not take any responsibility.

The Second party shall indemnify in the case of any irregularities/penalties imposed in case of segregated Waste at the common secured waste collection point is other then Bio- medical waste and pay the compensation for the damage caused to health or property of any person due to such failure.

The second party shall have the right to visit and inspect the first party's facility premises for verification of technical and administrative aspects related to the activities of the facility, i.e., transport, treatment and disposal of wastes; in relation to the Bio- Medical wastes handed over to the first party at the Hospital listed above.

The first party shall indemnify in the case of any irregularities/penalties imposed in case of improper collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of waste and pay the compensation for the damage caused to health or property of any person due to such failure.

This agreement can be terminated by either side with reasonable notice only to the other party.

The first party will provide acknowledgement to the second party mentioning no. of bags or cases received with quantities for treatment and disposal. The same has to be to be acknowledged by the second party.

The First party will give the Service Certificates or necessary documents required for the second party's records.
