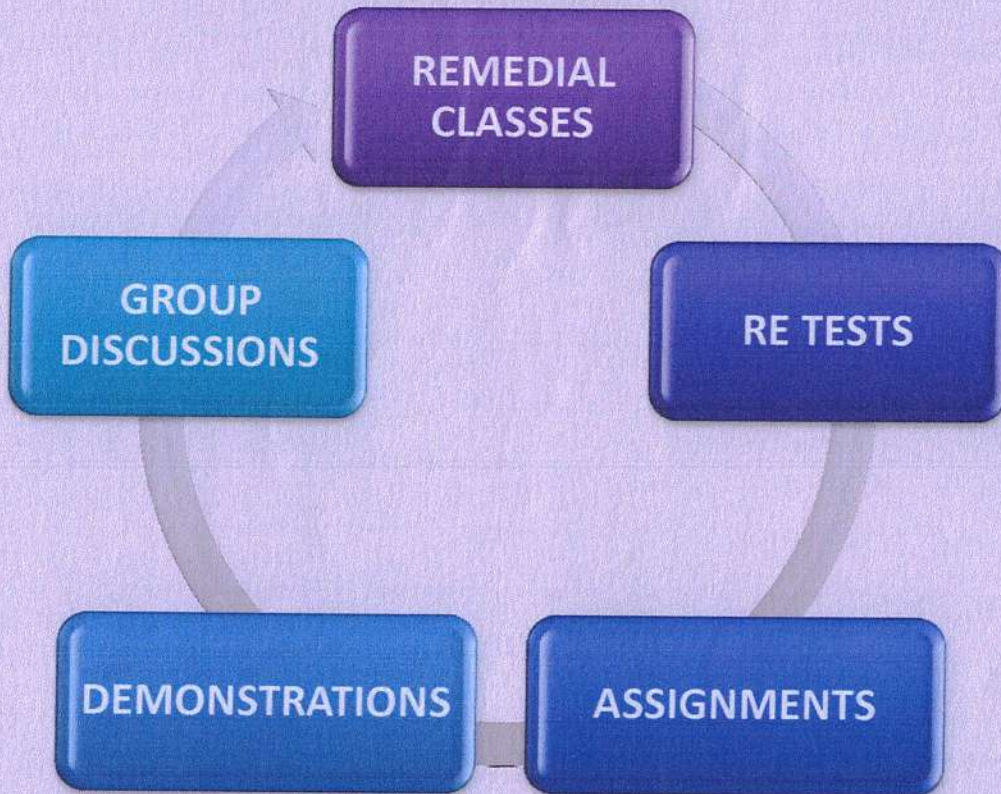

The various routes of sedation are as follows:

- Inhalational sedation: It is the most common form of sedation in which the loop of tube is given around the nose and the local anaesthetic solution is given.
- Intramuscular sedation: It is not at all preferred form of sedation to the pediatric patient as it may lead to the haematoma or intravascular damage.
- Intravenous sedation: It is the most common type of sedation with 100% efficiency and absence of any side effects.
- Intranasal sedation: It is not at all recommended in pediatric.

Conscious sedation is defined as the process of ~~being~~ partially unconscious state with continuous passage of airway with continuously responding to the verbal commands and physical stability is retained and physical sensation is absolute which can be applied by pharmacological and non-pharmacological types of conscious sedation.

There are various routes of sedations

Inhalation sedation

This is the recommended route for the conscious sedation in pediatric dentistry. The inhalation route is most reliable route in terms of onset of recovery. Efficiency is reduced when children object to the nasal tent or have difficulty in breathing.

Oral sedation

It is the most universally acceptable type of sedation.

Periodontics
 Resective Osseous Surgery

→ It is defined as a procedure of the changes in alveolar bone to rid it of deformities induced by periodontal disease process or other related factors such as erosion or tooth supra-eruption.

Procedure:

Steps:

- 1) Vertical grooving
- 2) Radicular blending
- 3) Flattening of interproximal bone
- 4) Gradualizing marginal bone

Step 1: Vertical Grooving

→ designed to reduce thickness of alveolar housing and to provide relative prominence to radicular aspects to the teeth.

→ also provides continuity from interproximal surface onto abutment surface.

→ performed with rotary instruments.

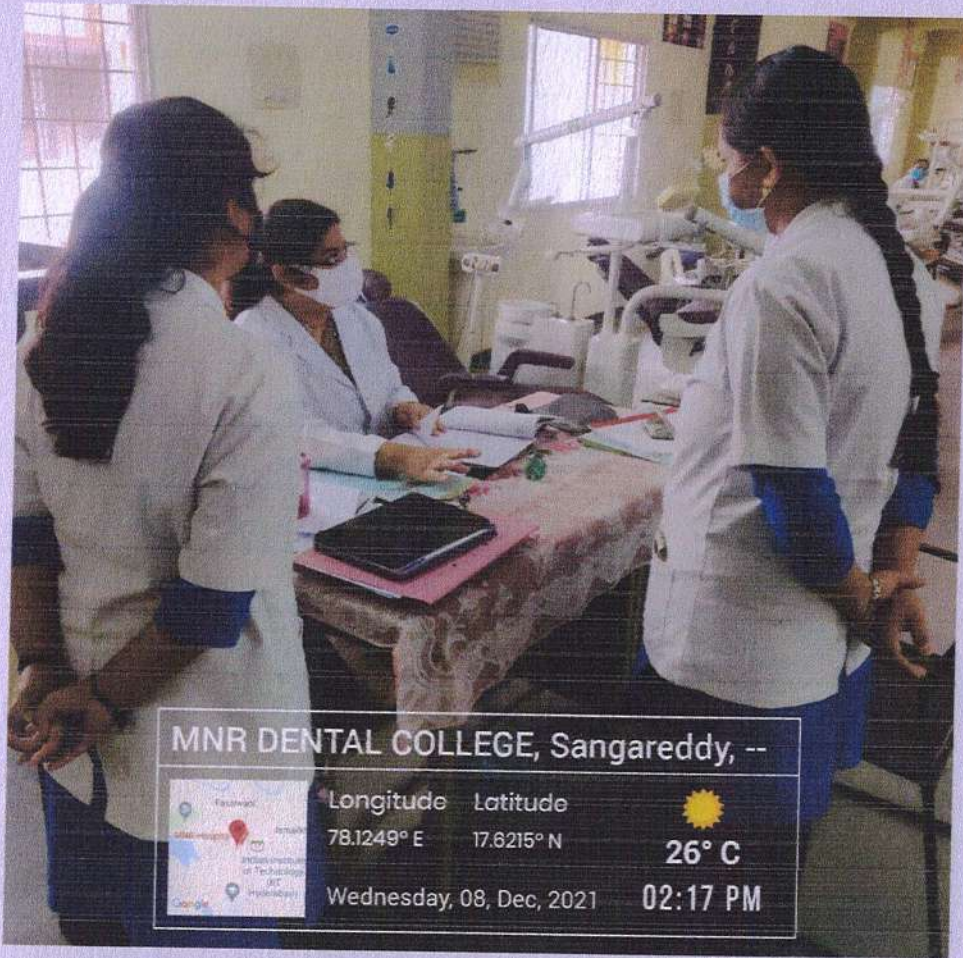

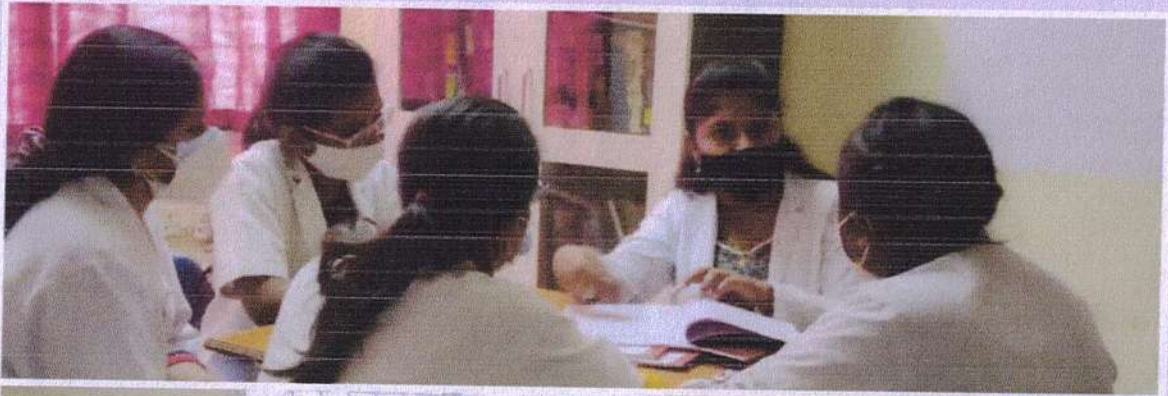

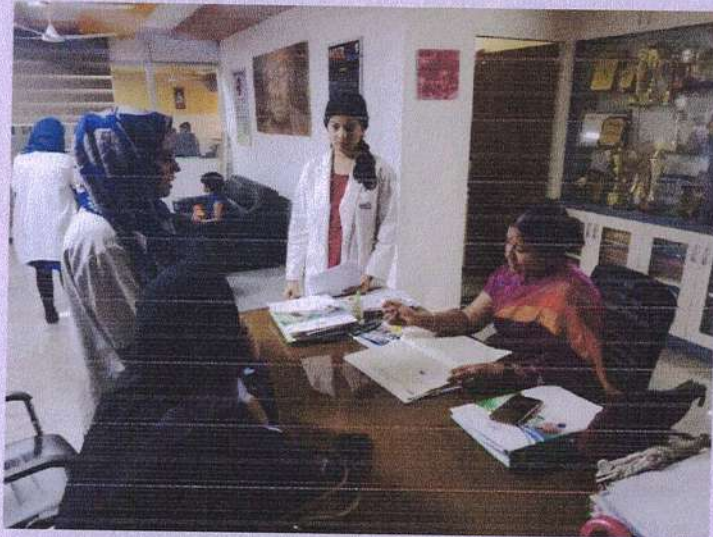
