The term "Party" shall mean either **MEDTRONIC** or **MNR-FRI** and "Parties" shall mean **MEDTRONIC** and **MNR-FRI** together.


WORKING AREAS;

d) Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with the preparation of this MoU.

2. Period of MoU

a) This MOU shall commence from the Effective date and shall be valid for an initial period of THREE years from that date unless:

- i. both parties agree and confirm in writing signed by both parties, at least three months before the date of expiration, that it should continue; or
- ii. Either party terminates the MOU by the giving of three months' written notice of termination to the other party.

b) This MOU may be renewed for subsequent period(s) on such terms and conditions as are mutually agreed to in writing by both the parties.

3. Responsibility of MEDTRONIC

- a) MEDTRONIC will appoint a point of contact for the relationship/engagement for the Collaboration.
- b) MEDTRONIC will provide technology/industry mentors who can help MNR-FRI to incorporate business rigor in projects at the innovation lab.

4. Responsibility of MNR-FRI

- a) MNR-FRI will provide a point of contact for the relationship/engagement.
- b) MNR-FRI will allow Medtronic to use the available Medical, Dental, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Homeopathy, Pharmacy, Engineering and Foundation for Research & Innovation facilities under the umbrella of MNR Educational Trust

5. Consideration

In furtherance to the objectives set out under the Collaboration, Medtronic to use all the available Medical, Dental, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Homeopathy, Pharmacy, Engineering and Foundation for Research & Innovation facilities under the umbrella of MNR Educational Trust.

6. Intellectual Property and Confidential Information:

- a) The treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this MoU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements to be entered on a case-by-case basis.
- b) The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MoU. If either Party wishes to disclose information that it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Parties will enter into a written, Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement for each such requirement.

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7. Jurisdiction and Arbitration

In the event of any dispute or difference between the parties hereto, the courts in Hyderabad alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try and matter arising between the parties here-to and accordingly both the parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Hyderabad as mutually decided at that time for this purpose.

Any dispute arising about any aspect of the MoU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the parties to this MoU. In case a settlement is not arrived at, the dispute/s will come under the purview of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 of India and the area of jurisdiction will be Hyderabad.

8. Termination

- a) This MoU will remain in force from the Effective Date and shall continue in effect for the period mentioned in clause 2, until either of the Parties expresses, in writing, to the other, a desire to terminate. The MoU may be terminated by either Party by giving three months' notice, in writing, to the other Party.
- b) If either party commits a material breach of any of the terms and conditions of the MoU (including under-payment or non-payment of invoices) the Other Party shall have the right to terminate the MoU if the Other Party fails to rectify the same within 30 days of being requested to do so in writing.
- c) In the eventuality of termination or non-renewal of MoU on expiry of MoU, it would be the responsibility of **MEDTRONIC** and **MNR-FRI** to complete their respective responsibilities and provide their services (except in case of under or non-payment of invoices) as identified in the MoU.

9. Amendment of MoU

- a) Two signed originals of this MoU will be produced with one to reside with each Party.
- b) If during the operation of MoU, circumstances arise which call for alteration/modification to this MoU, such alteration/modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing with the approval of the appropriate authority at **MNR-FRI** and **MEDTRONIC**. Such changes will be formalized, in writing, as an "Addendum" to this MoU and will be deemed to be a part of this MoU.

10. Contractual Provisions.

The Parties agree that the definitive agreements for each project under the Collaboration will include customary provisions as regards confidentiality, liability, intellectual property, indemnification, termination rights and other contractual provisions etc. as are customary for agreements of such type. The Parties acknowledge that the terms described in this MoU are indicative and not exhaustive of the terms and conditions that may be contained in the definitive agreements, which will include other customary provisions as mentioned above.

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

BETWEEN

MNR EDUCATIONAL TRUST

AND

PUSAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY



The Trustees of Pusan National University School of Dentistry (aka PNUD) on behalf of PNUD and MNR Educational Trust ("MNR ET"), Hyderabad, India hereby enter into an agreement of cooperation, made as of the 28TH day of Dec, 2018, to establish a program of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions.

I.

II.

- Receive students of the other institution for periods of study and/or research. It is understood that acceptance of any students will be at the discretion of the institution providing and hosting the learning experience, and that any visiting students will be responsible for his/her own living expenses and will, at all times, be subject to the policies and regulations of the hosting school and community.
- Organize symposia, conferences, short courses and meetings on research issues;
- Carry out joint research and continuing education programs; and
- Exchange information pertaining to developments in teaching, student development and research at each institution.

III.

Each department within the PNUD and MNR ET desiring to participate in an exchange shall designate a coordinator to oversee and facilitate the implementation of this Agreement. The coordinators, working with other appropriate administrators at the respective institutions, shall have the following responsibilities:

- to promote academic collaboration at both faculty and graduate student levels for research and study;
- to act as principal contacts for individual and group activities and to plan and coordinate all departmental activities for which cooperation with the other institution is desired;
- to distribute to each institution information about the faculty, facilities, research, publications, library materials and educational resources of the other institution; and
- if deemed desirable, to meet periodically to review and evaluate past activities and to work out new ideas for future cooperative agreements.

IV.

This general Agreement of Cooperation shall be identified as the parent document of any program between PNUD and MNR ET and shall be referenced in any agreement executed between the parties with respect to such program. Further agreements concerning any such program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the respective institutions. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be sought by either institution from external sources. No specific financial commitment by either party is to be implied from this Agreement.

V.

Except as may be stipulated in any specific program agreement which has been executed by both institutions, each institution shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its faculty members, employees, students under this Agreement. In addition, the cost of any extra courses or programs (i.e. video conferencing) requested by and specifically designated for MNR ET will be determined based on the programs.

VI.

Upon approval and execution by each institution, this Agreement shall remain in effect until Dec 27th, 2020 [the second year of effectiveness], unless terminated earlier by either institution. Such termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least ninety (90) days advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Termination shall be without penalty. If this Agreement is terminated, neither PNUD nor MNR ET shall be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses, which may result from such termination.

VII.

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts.

VIII.

MNR ET shall not use the name "Pusan National University" or the name of any school or division thereof, or use any logo or insignia of or otherwise identify PNUD or any school or division thereof, in any form of publicity or disclosure without the prior written consent of PNUD, which consent may be withheld or granted by PNUD in its sole and complete discretion at any time or times. PNUD shall not use MNR ET or the name of any school or division thereof, or use any logo or insignia of or otherwise identify MNR ET or any school or division thereof, in any form of publicity or disclosure without the prior written consent of MNR ET, which consent may be withheld or granted by MNR ET in its sole and complete discretion at any time or times.

Neither party shall communicate with members of the media or otherwise make any public announcement regarding the terms of this Agreement or of the collaboration contemplated herein, without the prior written consent of the other party.

IX.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between PNUD and MNR ET. Except as expressly provided in this Agreement, this Agreement supersedes all prior communications, oral or written, between PNUD and MNR ET. No revision or waiver of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of the parties.



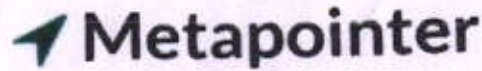

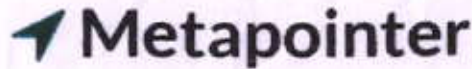
