#### **Communal socio-economic and other diversities.**

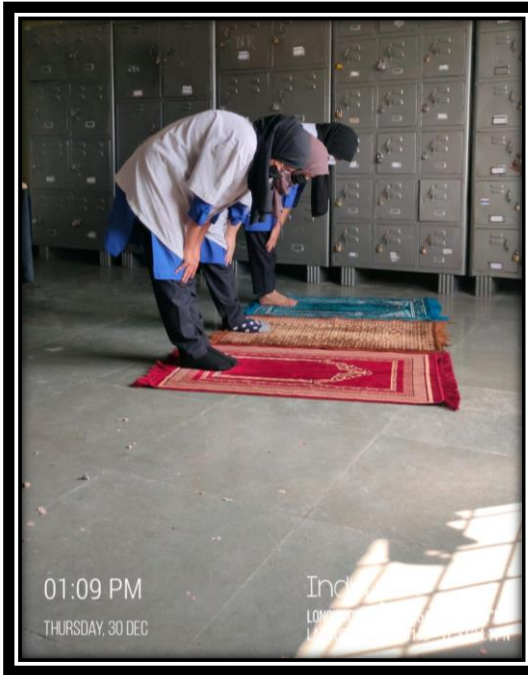

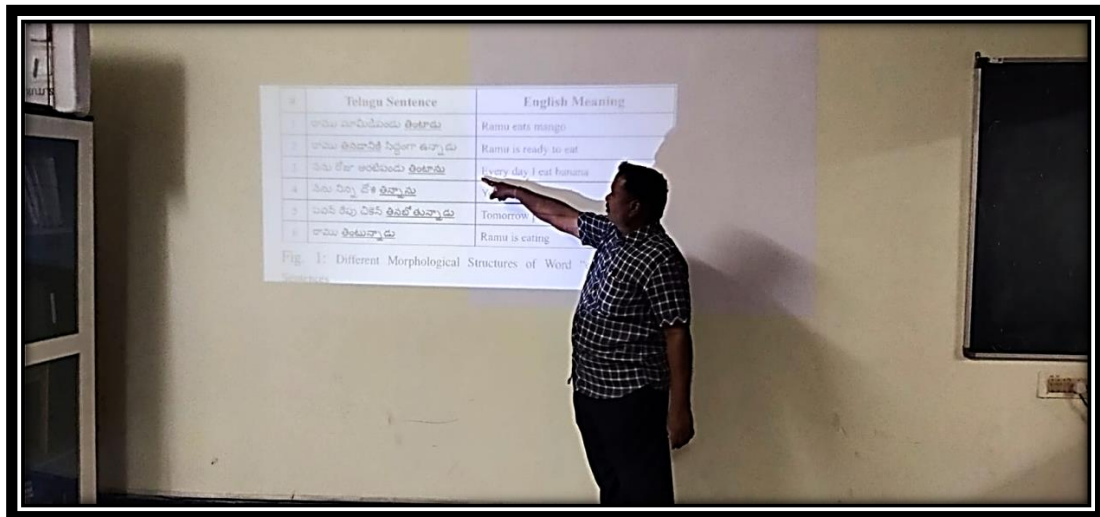

**No Tobacco Awareness Program**



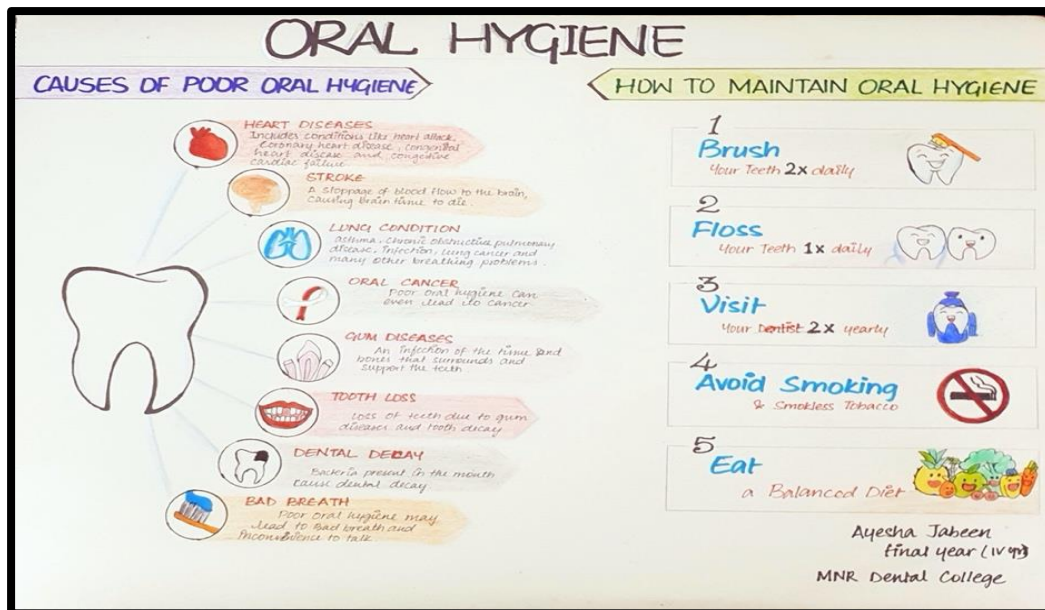
**Patient Education on Ill-effect of Tobacco Usage**
