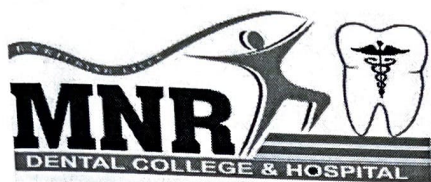

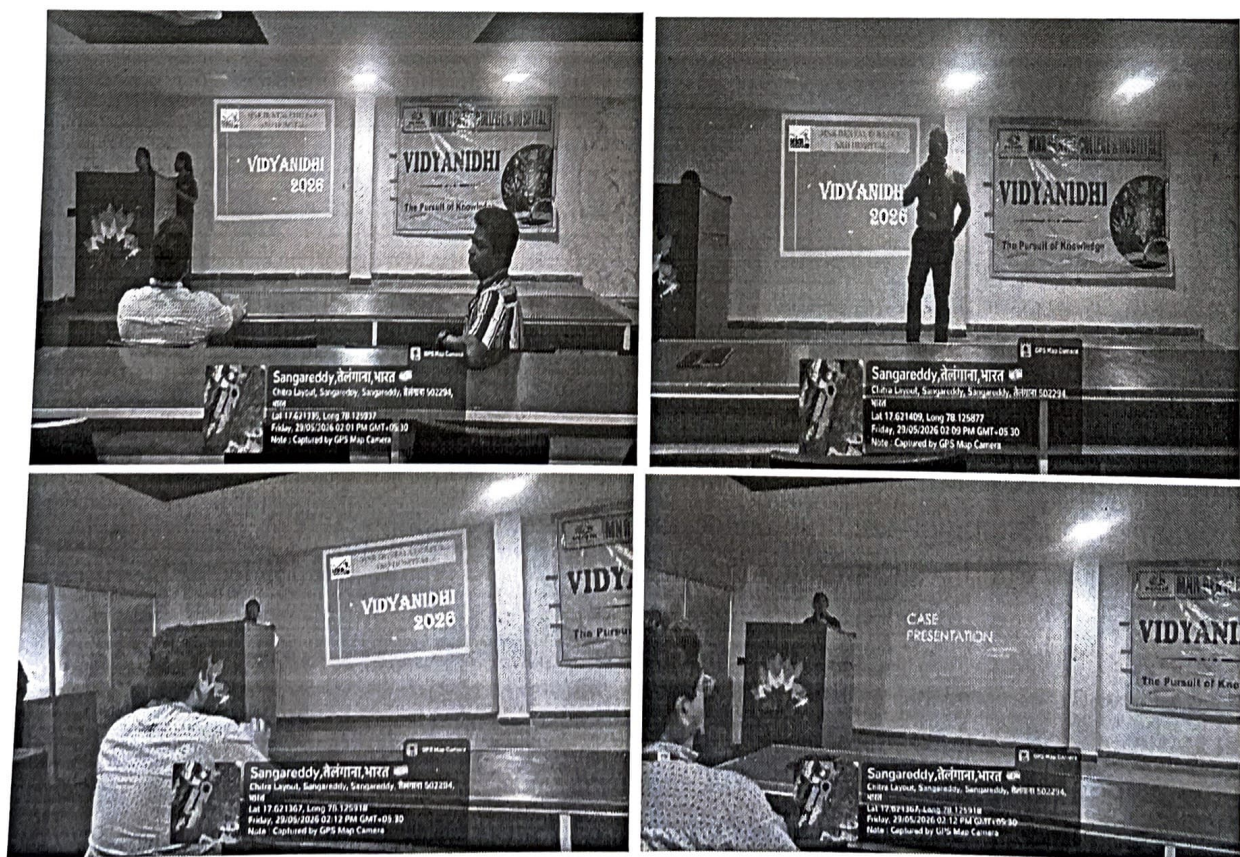
Both presentations were informative, interactive, and well appreciated by the audience. The session facilitated academic exchange and enhanced interdisciplinary learning among participants.
